### **Brace Yourselves - FSA Tests Are Coming**

Grade 4 and 7 teachers are currently receiving the letters in the courier, asking parents to request that their children be excused from taking the Foundation Skills Assessment (FSA) tests. These are also available in Punjabi and Chinese. We are concerned about the way the data from these tests are used to rank schools and the time they take away from meaningful teaching and learning. 

### **Surrey Primary Teachers' Association**

What is the SPTA and why should you join? The Surrey Primary Teachers' Association is a local specialist association which offers pro-d and networking opportunities FOR Surrey teachers organized BY Surrey teachers. Did you know last year we organized over 10 workshops and social get togethers, sponsored Colleen Drobot at the STA Day, and brought in Adrienne Gear for a dinner workshop? We are committed to improving primary teaching practice to benefit all of our Surrey students.

What do you need to do to join the SPTA? Our annual membership fee is \$20. The annual fee is valid from September to June of the current school year. (We will be having a "One Day Sale" membership drive on October 2nd with a half-price membership incentive. You must be physically on site to enjoy this one day discount rate of \$10.). We use the membership fees to cover speaker costs, honorariums to presenters, rental space (if needed), catering (if needed), snacks/refreshments at workshops, door prizes (we like to hand out a lot of them), and to put on social events for primary teachers. You will receive a receipt for your membership fees which can then be claimed back from your school pro-d funds. If you have volunteered to be the primary contact at your school, you can ask your admin if they will cover your membership fee so that you may keep your primary staff in the know.
