As part of meaningful reconciliation work, we reflect on the impacts of colonialism through self-education in order to be accountable to Indigenous people and pay attention to our students of Indigenous ancestry, providing them the tools for their success in the future. We are all on a path to learn more and understand the role of each of us as educators in healing the broken relationship with the First Peoples of this territory. We thank those who live on and care for the land.

Bargaining

With June 2022 marking the end of our current collective agreement, local bargaining for a new contract with the Surrey School District will open in November 2021. Staff Reps have been sharing a slide deck with information about what to expect over the next year. The survey soliciting your input has been sent out to Staff Reps. It should take about 15 minutes to complete and is due by Monday, May 31, 2021.

Given that many of the people in the Ministry of Education and BCPSEA have not changed since the Christy Clark years, we anticipate a tough round of bargaining. Nevertheless, we believe that a good deal for teachers can be achieved if we remember that there is strength in our solidarity and our commitment to public education.

Hearing Tests for Band, Music, and Shop teachers

If you work in an environment with hazardous levels of noise (more than 85 dB averaged over an eight-hour shift), your employer is required to have your hearing tested each year. The employer pays for the testing.

This year the hearing testing will be offered in October, one year from the last offering. Once things return 'back to normal', they will resume the testing annually in June.
