We acknowledge with gratitude and respect that STA members have the privilege of working on the unceded ancestral territory of the Coast Salish peoples, the q'wa:n'\(\hat{\chi}\) or (Kwantlen), qicəy (Katzie), qiqéyt (Qayqayt) and sɛmi aːmuː (Semiahmoo) who have cared for this land for thousands of years, and who continue to care for this land. As educators, we are committed to actions aimed at healing the broken relationship between settlers and Indigenous peoples.

TRUTH AND RECONCILIATION

Recently there has been extensive media coverage of Wet'suwet'en land defenders' arrests and resulting protests across Canada. Unfortunately, there has been very little explanation of the governance system that forms the background of the land defenders' actions.
