Extended Health Care Benefit Update

Effective January 1, 2023, registered counsellors and social workers will be added to the existing Psychologist coverage, and the combined coverage will increase from \$900 to \$1200. Coverage for Dexcom continuous glucose monitors will be added to the plan. The limit for services of chiropractors, massage therapists, physiotherapists, and acupuncturists will increase from \$900 to \$1000 each. Read about all updated changes

January 31 Qualifications Deadline

To be shortlisted for jobs that require certain qualifications in Rounds 1 and 2, teachers need to be listed in the District Qualification Book. Teachers who are interested in changing their assignments to such positions need to apply to the Human Resources Department (courier #481) by January 31, 2023, to have their qualifications evaluated. The evaluation will be completed by March 31, in time for Rounds 1 & 2. (CA, Article E.28.1).

Health and Safety

COVID-19 Symptoms

The present directions from the BCCDC are that if you have symptoms and tested positive for COVID-19, you can manage your illness similar to how you manage other respiratory infections like influenza (flu). Stay home if you feel sick and take prevention measures to limit the spread of infection.

If you have symptoms of COVID-19:

- Stay home and away from others until your fever is gone (without the use of medicines that reduce fever, like Tylenol) and you feel well enough to participate in daily activities.
- Avoid close contact with others, especially people at higher risk of severe illness or complications from COVID-19.
- If you cannot avoid close contact with others, take other prevention measures such as wearing a mask in indoor spaces and cleaning your hands regularly.

G.20.1 PURPOSE

Sick leave is intended to provide employees with a degree of protection against income loss where the employee is prevented, by illness or injury, from performing the employee's normal employment duties.
