# **Collective Agreement Notes**

#### **Retroactive Pay**

An issue has come to our attention regarding the application of retroactive pay for members who were on the first step of the local salary grid as of July 1, 2022. Members who were still on the bottom step of the salary grid at the time of implementation, or who were on the second step of the salary grid based on article B.1.6 in our Collective Agreement, should have moved up a step with a retroactive adjustment in pay from July 1, 2022. However, this was not being implemented by payroll in Surrey. Read more

The other two parts to the transfer process are the interview and a reference check. The STA's position is that the interview should come first, followed by the reference check.
