Dear friends,

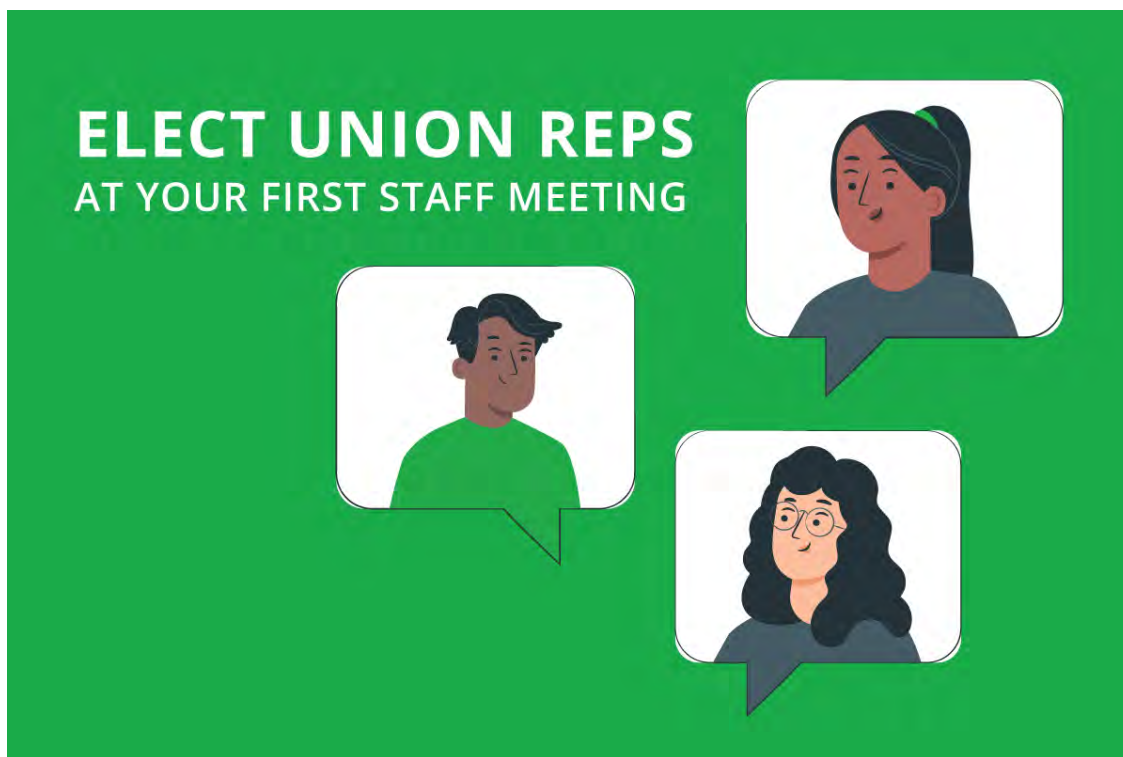

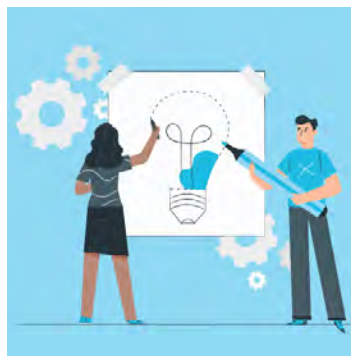
Deadline for Pro-D Funding Applications for the 2022-2023 School Year

The Minister of Health has approved changes to the Psychologists Regulation under the Health Professions Act (HPA) which will bring school psychologists under the regulation of the College of Psychologists of BC (CPBC). The STA will be meeting with the Employer to discuss incorporating this change into the School Psychologist Job Description.
