Remedy 2023

Please do not book any remedy time or book TTOCs for remedy. Currently there is no Remedy Agreement between the district and STA. We are negotiating the Carry-over Agreement and will send updates once this process is completed. As a result, teachers are not able to access historical remedy, which is any remedy accrued until the end of June 2023. As a reminder, Remedy is not accrued by any teachers in September. Data is gathered at the end of October and then information will arrive to impacted teachers in November.

Failure to Fills

Please make sure your school has a rotation set up through Staff Committee to ensure an equitable rotation of teachers who may be called on to cover a teacher absence. It is important that Staff Committee/Staff Rep monitors the frequency of non-enrolling staff being pulled for failure to fill coverage. This data must be reported to the District as it generates additional teacher staffing for the following school year. Read more

Department Head Release Days

Department Head Release Days are provided for leadership and organization in a secondary school department or program.

*B.29.7 LEADERSHIP AND ORGANIZATIONAL TIME

*a. Each school year, leadership and organizational time shall be provided to each department or program according to the following formula:

10-20 Teaching Blocks = 7 days 21-34 Teaching Blocks = 11 days 35 or more Teaching Blocks = 15 days

*b. The use of this time shall be jointly determined by the Principal / Vice Principal and the Department Head.

*c. This time may be assigned, for specific purposes, to other members of the department.
