- Participate in training for peer consultants
- Maintain confidentiality with clients

Notes:

Peer consultants will work as teacher volunteers. Release time and out-of-pocket expenses for work and training will be provided. Peer consultants may need up to 10 days of release time to carry out their responsibilities, inclusive of training days.

- Minimum of 7 years of teaching experience in BC public schools
- Current curricular knowledge
- Strong organizational skills
- Strong communication, planning and problem-solving skills/managing difficult situations
- Extensive repertoire of teaching skills and strategies
